Notice to All Exhibitors

Rules Applying to Dog Shows - Effective January 1, 2010

Chapter 11, Section 1, No dog shall be exhibited in a licensed or member dog show, except for dogs entered in the Miscellaneous Class unless it is either individually registered in the AKC Stud Book, or individually registered with a foreign registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration. See <http://www.akc.org/pdfs/rulebooks/RREGS3.pdf> for complete detail of the rule change.

Exhibitors Please Note

"Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations."

-NOTE-

In order to comply with the provisions of Wisconsin Statutes [s.95.21 (2)] and Administrative Codes [s.ATCP 11.52], relating to Statewide Rabies Control Program, the owner of any dog kept or exhibited in Wisconsin (other than a dog kept for educational or scientific purposes) shall have the dog vaccinated against rabies by a veterinarian at no later than 5 months of age and revaccinated within one year after the initial vaccination. Any person (including out-of-state exhibitors) who imports a dog into Wisconsin (for exhibition or any other purpose) must have a valid interstate health certificate or certificate of veterinary inspection for that dog, regardless of the age of the dog. The certificate must be completed by a veterinarian; accompany the dog when it enters this state; and indicate the current vaccination status of the dog. Vaccinations shall be administered by a veterinarian and comply with age and time standards and label instructions approved by the federal bureau for the type of vaccine used. Additional information regarding these regulations may be obtained from the Wisconsin State Veterinarian at 608-224-4888.

Regular Classes With Age Divisions

Please note the following AKC policies:

The age of a dog shall be determined up to and inclusive of the first day of a dog show. In a single show with multiple days of judging, the first day is considered to be the first day on which there is regular conformation judging.

Bred by Exhibitor Class

- All dogs entered in the Bred by Exhibitor Class must be individually registered with the American Kennel Club.
- The person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog.
- To exhibit in the class, family members must be a breeder and owner of record.

Non Regular Classes Involving Single Dog Entries

Veteran Dogs, 7 years and under 10 years

Veteran Dogs, 10 years and older

(Same classes for Bitches)

(Effective March 1, 1992, neutered dogs and spayed bitches are eligible to enter these classes)

Field Class Dogs, Field Class Bitches - Open to any English Cocker Spaniel eligible to regularly compete at a dog show that has earned the ECSCA Working Dog (WD) or Working Dog Excellent (WDX) title, or an AKC Field Championship (FC), Hunting Title (JH, SH, MH) or has placed in a stake at an AKC Cocker / English Cocker Spaniel Field Trial. Judging will be on conformation only, and the winner of the Field Dog and the Field Bitch classes may compete for Best of Breed Competition if otherwise undefeated in a breed class at this show.

Best of Breed Competition

Non Regular Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries

Stud Dog & Brood Bitch classes will be judged by Mr. Thomas F. O'Neal

Stud Dog Class - For Stud Dogs and **Two (2)** of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of the Get. Award will be based on the merits of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the *Dog Show Rules*, AKC policy or the Standard for the breed. **If the Stud Dog or Get are not entered in one of the other classes at this show for which it is eligible, the regular entry fee of \$30.00 must be paid for each. Entry fee for the Stud Dog Class as an "Additional Class" is \$20.00 for the unit.**

Brood Bitch Class - Same as Stud Dog Class, except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get. Note: In Accordance with Chapter 11, Section 8, a neutered male may be entered in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered in the Brood Bitch Class.

Brace Class - For **Two (2)** dogs of the same breed and **which must have one common owner and presented by a maximum of two handlers**. All Braces must be entered in the Brace Class and shown in the ring at the same time. Dogs may be entered for Brace Class competition only or as an additional entry. The dogs comprising a Brace must be named at the time of the entry. In making entries for "Brace Class only", full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Brace **MUST** be marked accordingly in the space for "Additional Classes". If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising each Brace must be so designated. "Brace No. 1", Brace No. 2". **Entry Fee for Brace as a first entry is \$30.00 per dog and \$20.00 for the unit as an "Additional Entry"**.

Team Class - Same as Brace Class, except for **Four (4)** dogs of the same breed **which must have one common owner and presented by a maximum of four handlers. Entry fee for Team as a first entry is \$30.00 per dog and \$20.00 for the unit as an "Additional Entry"**.

As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch and Brace Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

Parade of Titleholders

There will be a non-competitive Parade of Titleholders. Any English Cocker Spaniel Champion of Record (Field or Bench), Obedience Titleholder, Rally Titleholder, Hunting Test Titleholder, Agility Titleholder, or holder of an ECSCA Working Dog or Working Dog Excellent Certificate is eligible. Please include a brief resume of the dog's accomplishments to be read at ringside. Please limit write-up to 50 words or less. **Entry fee: \$15.00**

An AKC Recording fee of \$1.50 and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$1.50 will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, or Obedience Trial. If a dog is entered in more than one class in one of these events, the AKC Recording Fee and Service Fee is to be collected on the first entry only. (AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 2). **An AKC Recording Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each entry in any Licensed or Member Club Rally Trial.** If a dog is entered in more than one class in a Rally event, the AKC Recording Fee is to be collected on each of the entries of that dog. (AKC Rally Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 3) All Recording Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

No Entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. **Entry Fees** shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the event's Show Committee. - 1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "MIXED BREED." Variety, Breeder, Sire, Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
